We hope that you have an enjoyable stay with us here at Jubilee Lake Holiday Park.

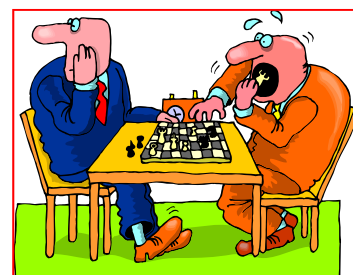

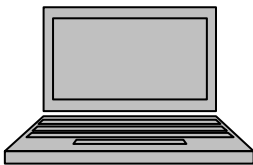
MOVIE NIGHTS



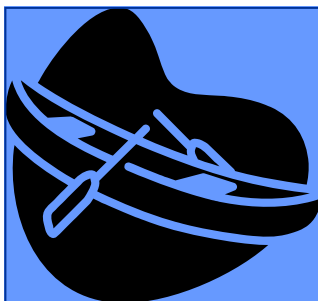
